1). Please control your students.

If every leader will do this we will have no problems.

- a). Know where they are at all times.
- b). Sit together at services.
- c). Help keep the noise down after 10 pm to be courteous to other hotel guests..
- d). These are beautiful hotels please make sure your students respect the privilege it is to stay here.

2). Remember that services are mandatory.

3). Sit in your proper section.

- a). Waiting in line as a group is strongly advised.
- b). There is no saving spots in the line.
- c). There is no saving seats in the first **20** rows of each section.
- d). Sections will rotate each service.
- e). Please explain this policy to your students and help enforce it.
- f). Cooperate with security and ushers.

3). Be a good role model.

- a). Be submissive to authority
- b). Obey rules
- c). Use hotel etiquette (no football or skateboarding in the halls etc.)
- d). HAVE A CHRIST LIKE ATTITUDE!!!!

4). Use common sense.

- a). Don't be alone in a room at any time with just one student.

5). Help to control students that aren't yours.

We can't be everywhere at once. If you see a problem, please care enough to get involved and help resolve the problem firmly yet with kindness.

6). Come prepared to minister

We need your help at the altars during prayer time. Please help direct students to fill in all areas so we can get everyone as close as possible. Pray for them. Guys pray for guys please. Girls pray for girls. Be familiar with the "Romans Row" (Romans 3:23, 5:8, 6:23, 10:9 & 10, 8:1) and be prepared to lead a student to Christ. What an awesome opportunity!

7). **Keep your leader card with you.**

8). **Help your youth pastor/leader put the wristbands on the students.**

- d). If a wristband is too loose or broken that person will not be admitted to services without first purchasing a replacement for **\$5.00** and they must have the old wristband or all the pieces.
- e). If a wristband is lost, the **Youth Pastor** must accompany the student to purchase a new band at the ticket booth or they will be charged the normal per service fee of \$25.00 per service.
