I AM A NEW TO GIRLS MINISTRIES AND HAVE LOTS OF QUESTIONS. WHO SHOULD I CALL FOR HELP?

Call Your Girls Ministries Sectional Team Leader

Most sections in the SoCal District have an appointed Girls Ministries Sectional Team Leader. These ladies are here to serve your church and act as liaison between the district coordinator and your church. The job of the Sectional Team Leader is to support your church by providing relevant training to help you get a Girls Ministry started or show you ways to take your Girls Ministry to the next level. Team Leaders plan FOCUS events (Fellowship Outings Connecting Us Spiritually) to enhance Girls Ministry in your church, help girls make friends from other churches, and to provide a place near your home town where girls can meet real-life world changers face-to-face and develop their mission heart for the world. I WANT TO CHARTER MY GIRLS CLUB, WHAT DO I DO?

Chartering your Girls Ministry Club with the SoCal District has several advantages. Charters are renewable in the month of September each year. Every chartered club in your church will receive an attractive Charter Certificate to be displayed in your club room. In addition, each girl in a chartered club will receive a membership card that gives them the ability to wear the Girls Ministries uniform. Chartering your Girls clubs saves your sponsors and girls money – all chartered churches can attend SoCal AG District Girls Ministries events at a 10% discount. I AM A LOCAL COORDINATOR AND HAVE SEVERAL NEW GIRLS MINISTRIES SPONSORS, HOW DO I GET THEM TRAINED?

Your Girls Ministries Sectional Team Leader provides an **excellent, relevant** one-day Girls Ministry Leadership Training Course where your sponsors can receive a successful completion certificate from the National Girls Ministries office. Typically, each Team Leader in SoCal schedules two trainings per year –one each spring and fall. You can email your Sectional Team Leader by clicking on the Sectional Team Leader link at www.socalag.org/girls to request training dates. Training registration is \$40/person for chartered churches and \$44/person for unchartered churches plus the cost of the Missionette Leadership Training Guide that can be purchased from Gospel Publishing House. Alumni can attend for \$20 or \$22/person depending upon charter status.

MY SECTION'S LEADERSHIP TRAINING SEMINAR IS SEVERAL MONTHS AWAY. HOW CAN I GET SOME GIRLS MINISTRIES TRAINING FOR MY SPONSORS NOW?

You can now purchase the Leader Training course on video, but we still highly recommend that you enroll your sponsors in the Leadership Training classroom experience offered in your Section. Your sponsors will not be able to receive the successful completion certificate from the National Girls Ministries office unless they complete their classroom training under the leadership of a SoCal AG Girls Ministries Sectional Trainers.
